## **Country Ownership**


The Governing Instrument for the Green Climate Fund: "The Fund will pursue a country driven approach and promote and strengthen engagement at the country level through effective involvement of relevant institutions and stakeholders."

Decision B.04/05:

- reaffirms that country ownership and a country driven approach are the core principles of the Fund, and
- establishes the functions of the NDAs/FPs.

## **National Designated Authority**

## **GCF** Architecture



#### Green Climate Fund: GCF

GCF is a multilateral fund delegated to operate the Financial Mechanism of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

#### Accredited Entities: AE

The fund is accessed through Accredited Entities (national, regional, and international) approved by the Board.

#### National Designated Authority: NDA/Focal Point


The NDA/Focal Point serves as an interface between its country and the GCF, and plays an important role in coordinating GCF activities.



## **Roles of NDAs & focal points**

Strategic oversight aligned to national priorities

Approval of readiness support



the measure to demonstrate ownership and commitments through meaningful engagement, including consultation with relevant national, local, community-level,

**Ownership** 

ensuring effective engagement of and ownership by relevant national and sub-national stakeholders such as the local governments at the municipal or village- level, private sector, local communities, academia and civil society organizations, including indigenous peoples and women's

ownership of GCF funding proposals from approval

## **GCF Guideline on Country**

country ownership continues throughout the project cycle, from readiness activities, and the pre-concept stage, through implementation to monitoring and evaluation of a project or program

Secretariat ensure country ownership in the development and implementation of projects



The programs should be aligned with nationally determined strategies and reflect local needs and realities.

> **Advocacy for Country Ownership**

Transparency about the no-objection procedure and the rationale behind decisions taken.

Climate programs and

projects should be

designed through

sovereign and democratic

processes that ensure the

full participation of all

relevant stakeholders

Country ownership should not be reduced to a no-objection clearance, but should promote bottom-up approaches that involve impacted communities, CSOs and other stakeholders.

Country ownership is determined not by government bodies alone, but through robust public participation and consent in the formulation, planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of climate responsive activities and financing.

Country ownership is now de facto understood as government ownership, with the national government acting as sole decisionmaker in GCF related matters.

NDAs facilitate comprehensive stakeholder consultations throughout the entire cycle of GCF operations, particularly with respect to the involvement of impacted communities.




## **CSOs engagement mechanism**






